Masterworks Chorus

Cappella Cantorum Masterworks Chorus provides singers the opportunity to perform challenging and diverse choral music with a professional orchestra, as well as professional and/or member soloists.

Two major concerts are offered each year, one in early December, and another in April/May. The chorus has also performed at Carnegie Hall and other venues.

Although originally formed of members from the Shoreline and lower Connecticut River Valley, the Masterworks Chorus now has members from more than 31 communities across the state.
