

Though the coronavirus pandemic has prevented us from having our usual variety of events, we are providing other ways for us to connect with you. We are creating virtual guided walks of our preserves by local experts; go to our website and click Explore to learn more. In December, we began a 52-trail challenge to hike all the trails in Lyme; we already have 9 people who have finished! Most recently, a generous donor has given us 180 acres of land on which we are now doing a natural resources study to determine the best way to manage this preserve. This parcel connects with large swaths of protected land that provide an important wildlife corridor.
