



Dear Friend,

As I sat down to write this letter, I heard that yet another litter of newborn kittens had been found dead in a dumpster. Most people are shocked by this—as they should be—but for me it was a sad reminder that no matter how much we have done to fight feline overpopulation, we can't win if people don't have access to affordable spay/neuter services. Here in Connecticut, as many people struggle to make ends meet, cases of animal abandonment and cruelty have increased. There are more stray and feral cats, and shelters are overflowing.

TEAM has a loyal clientele that has trusted us to provide excellent, affordable care for cats since 1997, but we receive hundreds of calls weekly from people who are desperate for our help. Some are folks who have recently adopted a cat or kitten, others are caring for homeless cats in their neighborhood, while a growing number simply can't pay the price at their "regular vet" and fear they may have to surrender their pet. Their reasons for choosing TEAM may differ, but the relief in their voices when they make an appointment is always the same. And that's because of you.

After 26 years and over 220,000 surgeries, we've got spay/neuter down. The *real* challenge is in keeping it affordable so that we can fix as many cats as possible *before* they reproduce. That's why we need—and appreciate—your continued support. These cats are just a few of the thousands we have spayed/neutered and vaccinated this year with your help.
